IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ ABOUT CHANGES IN 2011 ROTARY PARKING

The Rotary Club of Five Points is making changes in parking for 2011 to improve your game day parking / tailgate experience. Please read carefully the information below and the enclosed diagram (spaces are not to scale) for all types of parking available in the Back Lot.

Normal / regular non-assigned parking spaces: **\$235 each**

1. Normal / Regular spaces: 9 x 18 with tail gate space in the exit lane. These are the unnumbered spaces on the attached diagram.

NEW / assigned space with connected tent/canopy area.

2. Spaces T1-T29 shown on the diagram; **\$285 each**
 - a. Car: size 10 x 18
 - b. Tent/canopy : size 10 x 14

NEW / assigned space with tail gate space but without assigned tent / canopy space.

3. Spaces T30 and T31 shown on the diagram; **\$260 each**
 - a. Car size 10 x 18
 - b. Tail Gate space 10 x 7

NEW / assigned spaces with connected tent / canopy area.

4. Spaces T32 and T33 shown on the diagram sold as a pair **\$570 total**
 - a. Car size 10 x 18
 - b. Odd shape accommodates two cars, two 10x10 tents with extra space

NEW / assigned spaces, these are normal spaces with tail gate area in the exit lane.

5. Spaces are numbered 1-1, 2-1, 3.1.....22-1 on the diagram: **\$260 each**
 - a. Car size 10x18
 - b. Tail gate area in the exit lane

NEW / assigned spaces with tail gate space, but **without** sufficient space for 10x10 tent.

6. Spaces A to F and G to K as shown on the diagram: **\$260 each**
 - a. Car size 18 feet long with varied width plus tail gate area
 - b. None of these has area or space for a 10x10 canopy / tent

The process for allocating the assigned spaces this 2011 season will follow these steps:

After payment in full for all the desired spaces is received as a package (i.e. all at same time, at the address below):

- A. By email or phone contact LE Spradlin as shown below and express your preference for spaces. Please contact in advance if you want more information or clarity on these changes. Please do not send request info with the check payment as this will delay our space assignment process this year.
- B. We will not assign spaces until after the 5th of August. But you will be guaranteed a normal / regular parking space if demand for assigned spaces exceeds availability. Should demand exceed the assigned spaces available, we will refund the \$50 or \$25 reserved space premium to you.
- C. In assigning spaces, we will consider day of receipt of the paid request and requests for multiples of reserved spaces first in the process. Then individual requests. Items 1-4 above as well as 5-6 are open to individuals should the group demand not sell out.
- D. Final decisions on assignments will be based on our judgment for best utilization and operations.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Payment deadline is August 5th . If payment is not received by August 5th, the space will be forfeited. Corporate checks should indicate name of Parking Patron as indicated on the mailing label.

AGAIN THIS YEAR: No trailers, pull behind BBQ grills, golf car haulers, tailgating haulers without prior special approval from Parking Administrator. There is simply not enough room in the lot to accommodate them. Personal tailgating paraphernalia must be removed from the exit lanes between parking rows *before* patrons leave the lot to go to the stadium. This allow will allow other Patrons to exit during the game or immediately after the game without delay.

REMEMBER: Security is provided by the Richland County Sheriff's Department. The parking lots are clean and Porto-lets are available on site. Rotary Club members are on site at every game to assist parking patrons.

RULES AND EXCEPTIONS: Parking passes are checked at the gate and punched upon entry into the parking lot. Misuse of a pass by Parking Patron or their visitor(s) will result in forfeiture of said pass and removal from Patron list. Lost passes should be reported immediately to the Project Treasurer (803.753.3392) so the pass can be flagged as "lost." A replacement pass will be provided at a cost \$50 *upon request of Parking Patron* and can be obtained from the Project Treasurer (see number above). As in years past, RVs are not permitted without special permission by prior arrangement and require purchase of 2 spaces. Finally, while the use of tents up to 10 x10 in the lots is not prohibited, please be mindful not to intrude into someone else's parking space. Large tents that could block fire lanes or impede traffic may have to be moved at the discretion of the Rotary Club.

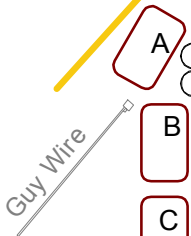
